MRSA (Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus)

MRSA is a drug-resistant superbug that infects people, mainly while in hospital. It can be treated and is not fatal.



Hospital

A big building that allows doctors to treat patients; where MRSA is quite common to get infected with.



Infection

An infection is a pathogen that invades the body and creates new cells that make you feel ill. They are usually treated with antibiotics.



Swelling

One of the symptoms of MRSA, you can often get swelling in places that are infected.



Warmth

Having MRSA as an infection, you may find discomfort in areas that are warmer than usual. This is one of the symptoms of MRSA.



Pain

Having MRSA as an infection, you may have a symptom of pain in places. It can cause some discomfort.



Pus

A goeey liquid that is the result of toxins that want to escape the body, pus is often an off-white colour, and can be treated with creams.



Redness

Another symptom of MRSA, redness in areas local to the infection present themselves.



Prison

Another place you can get infected with MRSA is in prison, along with hospitals. It is a common bug that goes around.



Nursing Home

Another place you can get infected with MRSA is a nursing home. It is a common bug that goes around.



Antibacterial Cream

A method of treatment for MRSA is to use an antibacterial cream. While MRSA won't go just from this, prolonged use of it will reduce it significantly.



Antibacterial Soap

A method of treatment for MRSA is to use antibacterial soap. This can help reduce the symptoms of MRSA.
