## Drugs

Drugs that are used in trials are specifically being tested to see if they both work effectively, and if there are side effects on humans.



## Trials

A process used to see if there are side effects when humans take specific drugs.



## Stages

Drugs trialling is done in stages to first test small amounts, and then ramp up trials to larger scales if successful.



## Human Testing

Using human volunteers, testing of drugs in trials means that it is tested on humans to see the effects of the drugs being tested.



## Efficacy

This is how effective a drug can be for its intended purpose - paracetamol is constantly being tested to test for efficiency at relieving pain.



## Placebo

During drugs trials, a placebo may be given. It looks like the drug, but it doesn't have any of the drugs within them, and can determine false positives.



## Small Groups

Drugs are trialled on humans in small groups before going nationwide or on a bigger scale.



## Nationwide

Drugs trials can be given nationwide, where volunteers up and down a country are tested on the drugs to find side effects.



## Worldwide

Going worldwide for trials can mean that the drugs being tested are generally good for consumption, but to check other ethnicity or types of people.
