Kingdoms

A kingdom is a category that animals, insects and other organisms are classified into.



Animalia

Animalia is the kingdom that classifies all the animals in the world. Any animals are put here – cat, dog, elephant, polar bear, etc.



Plantae

All of the world's plants are classed in plantae. Everything from dandelions, oak trees, euphorbia, ferns, all placed in this kingdom.



Fungi

Fungi is the kingdom where things like mushrooms and even single-celled fungi are classed.



Protista

Having features like bacteria, but also features like a multi-celled organism, protista were classed in their own category to distinguish them from the rest.



Bacteria

Single-celled organisms that fall into this category include good bacteria like those found in your gut, and bad ones such as a common cold. Archaea are also placed here.



Eubacteria

A redefining of the bacteria category, to allow a sixth kingdom to be included, eubacteria are just bacteria alone, without archaea.



Archaeobacteria

The sixth kingdom, archaeobacteria are classed on their own in this example to include the different types of archaea.
